

Managing a Skein

When thread comes in a skein that is looped back on itself, meaning you can't pull the threads out; we suggest the following to manage the thread.

- Slide both labels off and save them.
- Find where the bundle of threads is tied, hold the skein in the tied area and give the skein a gentle shake. It should fall out into a long loop.
- Remove the tying thread and cut the skein in half at this point. This gives you a skein of working size threads.
- Thread the labels you have saved back onto the threads of the skein
- Separate the thread into three sections and work a loose plait. Make sure that the labels stay at the top.
- When you want to use a thread, select a thread from the top near the labels and carefully pull it out of the braid.
